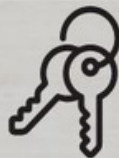

Despite the continuing challenges of the pandemic in 2021, we were able to keep moving our mission forward with the help of our Core and Community Volunteers. Our volunteers continued to come out to build homes, partner with families, and help ReStore thrive.

Our Critical Home Repair Program served 26 families and was so successful, we are planning to increase our capacity to 50 repairs in 2022!

Our Love Your Neighborhood events took place over the summer as well as a community event in September. A total of 14 exterior repairs were completed in the Portland neighborhood. Plans for 2022 include 3 LYN events in the Russell, Parkland, and Portland neighborhoods.
